Montana Chamber of Commerce Endorses Judge Dan Wilson in Supreme Court Race

HELENA, Mont. - The Montana Chamber of Commerce today announced their endorsement of Judge Dan Wilson for Associate Justice on the Montana Supreme Court.

Both Judge Wilson and Judge Eddy have strong legal backgrounds. However, the Montana Chamber identified Judge Wilson's thoughtfulness and depth in answering questions, as well as his unbiased and diligent approach to deciding cases, as key factors to help him earn the Chamber's endorsement.

A balanced judicial system is essential to a strong business climate. Finding information about candidates for these highly technical, non-partisan positions is often difficult, especially for an average voter. To this end, the [Montana Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors](#) decided to endorse candidates in the 2024 Supreme Court races and has continued in the 2026 election cycle.

"We are thankful to both Supreme Court candidates for taking the time to meet with our expert committee," said Montana Chamber President & CEO Todd O'Hair. "Wilson will bring integrity and thoughtful analysis to the Montana Supreme Court, along with the understanding that stability and predictability in our court system are vital to the success of Montana businesses."

A committee of legal experts, attorneys, and Montana business leaders interviewed both Supreme Court candidates. The full Montana Chamber Board affirmed the interview committee's endorsement recommendations.

"It can be difficult to find sufficient information on candidates for the Supreme Court. I trust the Montana Chamber of Commerce to endorse candidates that understand the importance of an independent judiciary and stability of our business climate," says Tony Rosanova, Chair of the Montana Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors.

Members of the Montana Chamber's review committee conducted these individual interviews in late February. The review committee met to finalize their endorsement; this recommendation was forwarded to the full Chamber Board for discussion and approval in March.
